- ✓ Do your own composting and save transport routes whilst obtaining valuable natural fertiliser. (But don't put leftover food in your compost: They attract rats.)

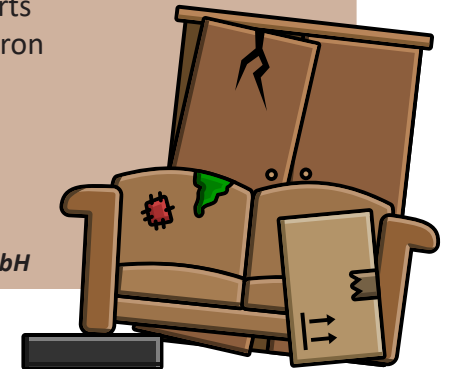

- Building materials
- Fittings that are an integral fixture of the house or garden (windows, doors, washbasins, garden playground equipment)
- Mirrors or other flat glass
- Car parts
- Scrap iron

Information on collection services

Tips concerning the organic waste bin



- Ensure that the organic waste bin is placed in a protected location during extreme temperatures (heat/frost).
- Line the bottom with paper or shrub cuttings.
- Larger quantities of lawn cuttings should be loosened up with twigs or similar, so that the moist organic waste does not rot so quickly.
- Shrub cuttings (especially from thorny shrubs or coniferous trees) should be cut into small pieces, if possible.
- Allow particularly damp waste to dry first and wrap in absorbent, rottable material.
- Cover kitchen waste with a thin layer of sand, earth or grass cuttings to absorb moisture and reduce odours
- Food leftovers of animal origin should be wrapped in paper to prevent infestation by maggots.
- Maggot infestation can be controlled by sprinkling a thin layer of lime. Any type of natural lime is suitable (no fertiliser).
- Please do not use bags made of recyclable plastic! These rot too slowly.
- Alternatively, we recommend using recyclable, compostable (paper) bags from retailers, which are marked with the „seedling“ symbol and the European standard number EN13432 as proof of compostability.
- Starch sacks for the collection of uncomposted outdoor organic waste can be collected from the municipal Baubetriebshof depot during opening hours for a fee (€ 1/piece) and brought back filled.



Green cuttings



The collection of green waste (up to 3 cubic metres per household and a maximum of 50 kg per packaging unit) takes place twice a year. The green waste must be placed in a clearly visible location on the street by 6 a.m. on the collection dates (spring and autumn).

Please note that all materials (bags, cords etc.) must be decomposable!

Bulky goods



Since 2025, there has been a central street collection of bulky waste again. It takes place twice a year and is carried out by the Stenau waste disposal company. The exact dates can be found in the waste calendar.

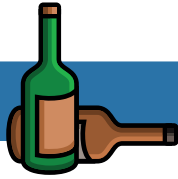
The Stenau company asks that the bulky waste be placed in a clearly visible location on the street by 6 a.m. at the latest on the day of collection.

As the waste is openly accessible for a while, the city of Ochtrup calls on all residents to handle it responsibly. Chemicals and materials containing harmful substances are not bulky waste!

can be delivered to the Kockmann collection point at the acceptance fees applicable for the Steinfurt district.

Pollutants can be delivered to the mobile pollutants collection vehicle in Ochtrup on four Thursdays a year free of charge:

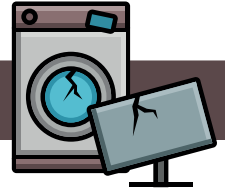

Waste oils, used batteries and old rechargeable batteries are by law accepted by their traders free of charge.

Electronic waste



Ochtrup residents can deliver discarded electrical appliances from private households free of charge to the collection point at Kockmann (Weinerpark 17).

They must be assignable to one of the following containers for collection:

1. Large household appliances
2. Refrigeration units
3. Media and communication technology (PC, radio, telephone etc.)
4. Fluorescent lights
5. Compact electrical appliances (hairdryer, gaming consoles etc.)

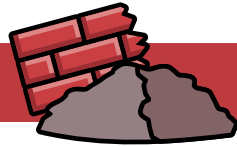
Silage tarpaulins

Building debris



Construction and renovation debris is not classified as bulky waste, but must be disposed of by private waste management companies or taken to a landfill or recycling facility.

Debris should be separated into 2 groups already on site:

1. POLLUTANT-FREE CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS/ MIXED CONSTRUCTION SITE DEBRIS

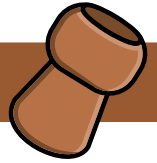
- Materials consisting of stone, ceramics, porcelain
- Mortar, concrete and masonry rubble
- Brick debris
- Timber from construction and demolition
- Glass, metal and synthetic waste
- Foam materials
- Insulation materials
- Bituminous roofing felt
- Wall claddings
- Carpet scraps
- Styrofoam

2. ASBESTOS WASTES

(e.g. roofing sheets and façade panels, night storage heaters)

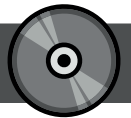
Following prior registration and consultation, Kockmann may, under certain circumstances, dispose of such waste containing hazardous substances for a fee.

Cork



Natural corks are a precious resource and too good to throw away! Clean bottle corks can be returned to the Baubetriebshof depot. They are collected nationwide and forwarded to the Hanauerland workshops in Kehl, from where they are processed into insulating materials.

CDs and DVDs



Used data storage discs such as CDs and DVDs are collected at the Baubetriebshof and in the Bauamt (building authority office). They are used to produce new plastic products for the electrical, electronics and automotive industries. For data protection reasons, please scratch the CDs thoroughly before handing them in!

Diapers











Disposable diapers belong in the residual waste bin. Households generating more used diapers than will fit into a 240-litre bin can drop their surplus diapers off at the Baubetriebshof in the so-called "Pampers container".
